#### COMMENT:

A. Pharmacy Technician Certificate. The Pharmacy Technician Certificate is a 16 credit hour certificate that prepares individuals, under the supervision of pharmacists, to prepare medications, provide medications and related assistance to patients, and manage pharmacy clinical and business operations. Includes instruction in medical and pharmaceutical terminology, principles of pharmacology and pharmaceutics, drug identification, pharmacy laboratory procedures, prescription interpretation, patient communication and education, safety procedures, record-keeping, measurement and testing techniques, pharmacy business operations, prescription preparation, logistics and dispensing operations, and applicable standards and regulations. Upon completion of the certificate, students will be prepared and qualified to sit for the Industry Certifications of Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) and Pharmacy Technician Certification Board Exam (CPhT). The Pharmacy Technician Certificate is being brought for review and approval.

<u>RECOMMENDED ACTION</u>: Approve the Pharmacy Technician Certificate for this to be sent to the Kansas Board of Regents. One approved, the Certificate will be offered at Cloud County Community College in the Fall of 2021.

**B. sUAS Certificate.** The sUAS Certificate is a 18 credit hour certificate that prepares individuals for careers in the field of remotely piloted aircraft and for use of sUAS to support other industries. The Certificate aligns with the Cloud County Community College sUAS 30 credit hour certificate and A.A.S. degree allowing students to gain an additional stackable

certificate in the sUAS field of study. The sUAS Certificate is being brought for review and approval.

<u>RECOMMENDED ACTION</u>: Approve the sUAS Certificate for this to be sent to the Kansas Board of Regents. One approved, the Certificate will be offered at Cloud County Community College in the Fall of 2021.

C. Welding Certificate. The Welding Certificate is a 18 credit hour certificate that prepares individuals to apply technical knowledge and skills to join or cut metal surfaces. The certificate includes instruction in arc welding, resistance welding, brazing and soldering, cutting, high-energy beam welding and cutting, solid state welding, ferrous and non-ferrous materials, oxidation-reduction reactions, welding metallurgy, welding processes and heat treating, structural design, safety, and applicable codes and standards. Upon completion of the certificate, students will be prepared and qualified to sit for the Industry Certificate of American Welding Society (AWS). The Welding Certificate is being brought for review and approval.

<u>RECOMMENDED ACTION</u>: Approve the Welding Certificate for this to be sent to the Kansas Board of Regents. One approved, the Certificate will be offered at Cloud County Community College in the Fall of 2021.
