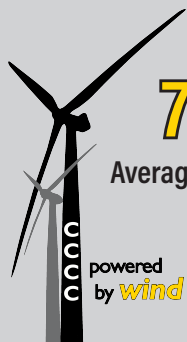
## ANNUAL TUITION & FEES

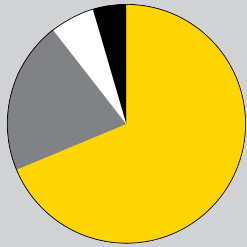

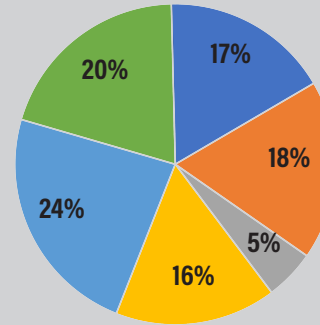

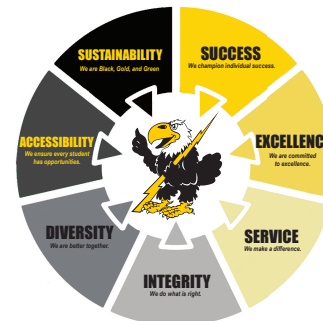
