C. Approval of Solar Bid for a Mechanical Systems Trainer – Sole Source. Because of increased enrollment in the Wind Energy Technology program and the addition of the Solar Technology program, we have increased the size of mechanical systems courses. The department would like to purchase an additional trainer which would allow the class to be divided into smaller working groups, so students will have more direct hand-on experience with the trainer. The department would like to purchase a trainer like the training stations already being used in the course to allow for consistent instruction and student experiences. Only one vendor makes the trainers being used by the department. The department is asking for approval of a sole source bid for a mechanical trainer purchase to be used by the Solar Technology and Wind Energy Technology programs. The department has secured Perkins funds for \$25,000 and the remainder will be submitted to the County Commissioners to be paid by the Meridian Way Grant Funds.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve the invoiced bid (see attached) from Innovative Education Systems (IES) in the amount of \$38,945.81 to purchase a mechanical systems trainer and authorize a \$25,000 payment from the Perkins grant.
