CPR Requirement

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Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certification is required and must remain current throughout the Nursing Program. Only certification offered directly through the American Heart Association for Healthcare Providers or the American Red Cross- CPR for the Professional Rescuer will be accepted.

Documentation of completion through this certification training must be in the Nursing Program office prior to the start of the Nursing Program.

It is the responsibility of the student to be aware of certification expiration dates and recertify in a timely manner, so as not to allow any gap in compliance. Failure to have a current CPR certification will result in no admission to clinical activities, which could result in failure of the course.
