

TOPIC:

Electronic Devices

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Students should inform relatives, friends and employers that calls/texts should not be received at the facility or on a personal phone during classroom or clinical experiences unless there is an **emergency**.

This applies to nursing students in clinical, lab and simulation lab settings. Faculty may approve an exception to this policy for medical reasons. Student cell phones must be turned off or set to silent during class times. Students are required to follow this procedure when attending class.

No cell phones or other electronic devices will be allowed in the testing area.

Use of cell phones and other mobile devices is prohibited in patient care areas. In the practicum setting, electronic devices should only be accessed in a private setting and only for clinical use, in accordance with the facility policy. Use in certain areas is at the discretion of the supervising instructor

They may not be used for communication of any kind during class or clinical times. This includes, but is not limited to calls, texts or social networking. The student is expected to exhibit responsible use of mobile devices. Facility policies vary, and override school policies on this issue.

The college or clinical facility are not responsible for lost or stolen electronic devices.
