Foundation Scholarships

Students who complete the scholarship application by March 1 will be considered for CCCC Foundation scholarships. Foundation scholarships involve memorial and other designated scholarships. Awards are made according to rules and regulations governing each award. The requirements, amounts, and the option to renew vary with each scholarship. Some scholarships are not available every year.

Academic Scholarships

First-time, full-time students who complete the scholarship application before March 1 will be considered for Academic Scholarships. To renew the scholarship, the student must maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average, depending on the scholarship, and have completed 12 credit hours per academic semester. Students must complete the renewal letter before May 1 to be considered for renewal of the scholarship for the next academic year.

To be considered for Academic Scholarships and Foundation Scholarships from CCCC, a student must complete and submit the Scholarship Application before **March 1** for the scholarship committee to review. For questions about the Scholarship Application process, email: nick.lenhard@cloud.edu

⚡ FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID

Many Cloud students rely on Federal Financial Aid to help with the expenses of college. Our staff can assist you in filling out the FAFSA, access financial aid records, and discuss your personal financial situation. This application is FREE to complete and is available online at fafsa.ed.gov. Cloud's Federal School Code is 001909.

⚡ MILITARY EDUCATION BENEFITS

We understand VA and TA funding at Cloud and help qualified individuals take advantage of those Military Education Benefits available to them. If you should have questions about using Military Education Benefits, we offer a Veteran's Representative and a VA School Certifying Official on our Geary County Campus. ⚡ OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS



HOME OF CHAMPIONS


The Cloud Thunderbirds have a winning tradition - in the classroom and on the field and the court.

In 2022, the Cloud County track and field teams had six NJCAA national champions, and both the men's and women's teams were indoor and outdoor Region VI champions.

The baseball team had its most successful season in years, playing in the NJCAA Plains District Tournament for just the second time in program history.

And, our other sports teams consistently finish at the top of the Jayhawk Conference.

In the classroom, eight teams finished the academic year with a grade point average above 3.0 to earn Academic Team of the Year honors, and 43 student-athletes received NJCAA All-Academic honors. Sixteen of those athletes had a 4.0 GPA.



Women's NJCAA sports include: basketball, cross country, softball, indoor/outdoor track and field, and volleyball.



Men's NJCAA sports include: baseball, basketball, cross country, indoor/ outdoor track and field, and wrestling.
