## **Scholarships**

Scholarships can be applied to help pay for charges on the student account. Scholarships can include institutional scholarships from CCCC (academic, athletic, activity, foundation) or outside scholarships from an outside donor.

#### **Grants**

Check your financial aid award letter regarding eligibility for federal grants. You can also call the Financial Aid Office to get general information regarding possible eligibility and amounts. After completion of the FAFSA Application at <a href="www.studentaid.gov">www.studentaid.gov</a>, you should have received a confirmation page that stated preliminary aid eligibility. The amounts are listed for the entire academic year. Please take this into consideration when estimating semester charges and assistance.
